

MFG Day is October 6, 2023



Held annually on the first Friday in October with events that continue throughout the month, MFG Day—Manufacturing Day—helps show the reality and future of modern manufacturing careers by encouraging thousands of companies and educational institutions around the nation to open their doors to students, parents, educators, and community leaders. The state of Minnesota is once again celebrating October as Manufacturing Month. With 41,369 jobs at 1,212 establishments, manufacturing is the second largest industry in Central Minnesota. Total payroll for manufacturing topped \$2.64 billion, more than any other industry sector in the region. Manufacturing is vital to Central Minnesota's economy and the region has the second highest concentration of Manufacturing in the state.

The resounding result was one - at the time, relatively new - brand: Chipotle. The other? A Starbucks for those caffeine-addicted car drivers on their way to work.

The feedback, at the time, was people needed to be patient.

"Everything we always here from franchises like that is that St. Michael, and communities like us, needs more rooftops," said Community Development Director Marc Weigle. "When things stalled out in 2008 and the years after, for a while, those franchises focused on larger, second ring suburbs like Plymouth, Woodbury, and places like that."

Howard Lake to break new ground with the state's first ever net-zero library

After exploring its options for an updated public library in recent years, the City of Howard Lake has decided on a design for a new facility that will make history as the first-ever net-zero library in Minnesota and the upper midwest.



A net-zero energy building is a building that can generate energy onsite in a quantity that is equal to or greater than the total amount of energy that it consumes. The building generates energy using renewable resources.

The city's decision to pursue an updated library first came several years ago when it determined that the current library could no longer fully satisfy the needs of the community.

Built-in 1979, the current library lacks an abundance of sunlight and, more importantly, an elevator.

Xcel Energy® Plans to nearly triple the amount of solar on Upper Midwest system by 2028.

Company seeks to expand Upper Midwest's largest solar project at Sherco site

Xcel Energy is proposing to add an additional 250-megawatt solar project near the existing Sherco plant site in Becker, Minnesota, which will soon be home to the Upper Midwest's largest solar development and represents an important piece of the company's clean energy future. Today, Xcel Energy is asking the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission to add a third solar array adjacent to the 460-megawatt Sherco Solar project already under construction. The three solar projects are expected to be complete by the end of 2025 and will replace the capacity of the Sherco plant's first coal unit that is scheduled to retire later this year. As part of its expansion of solar energy it delivers to customers, Xcel Energy is also proposing to purchase power from the 100-megawatt Apple River solar project being developed in northwest Wisconsin.
